Qualification of Candidate (1)

Item	Contents
Candidate	<p>Any Head Coordinator who is eligible and who is interested in nominating himself or herself for the next two years should send their names to the APACA secretariat at APACA@schdule-coordination.jp/ by October 26, 2012. Please make sure that you have a fellow coordinator or schedules facilitator to second your application before you put your name forward.</p> <p>Only head coordinators of at least one level 3 airport is eligible for election to the APACA. Your name will then be added to the list of potential candidates for election at APACA/5 in November 2012. It is very important before you seek nomination to the APACA that you carefully consider if you are able to fully meet the following essential criteria.</p>
Arguments	<p>(1) Should the candidate be coordinator (level 3), facilitator (level 2) or both?</p> <p>(2) Should the candidate be limited to head coordinator or head facilitator?</p>

Qualification of Candidate (2)

Item	Contents
Criteria	<p>The criteria for election to Chair and Vice-Chairs of APACA are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- You should ideally work for an independent coordination organization e.g. not under the control of a single entity such as an airline or CAA.- You have a reasonable command of English (written and spoken – the meetings and working papers will only be in English)- You are willing and able to travel to meetings worldwide at your own cost. Meetings take place basically 2 times a year at the occasion of IATA Slot Conference and other meetings may take place outside of IATA. It is very important that you attend all the meetings.- You are willing and able to contribute ideas and issues for consideration at the meetings and, where appropriate, to produce working papers and presentations for discussion.
Arguments	<p>(1) Should the independent coordination organization be matter?</p> <p>(2) Should the travel expense be limited only to IATA Slot Conference?</p>

Item	Contents
Election Process	<p>Attached please find the articles of APACA which include information about the election process and voting procedure (Article 6; General Assembly, Article 7; Chair and Vice-Chairs, Article 9; Voting, Quorum).</p> <p>When all the nominations have been received for Chair and two Vice-Chairs positions, the names will be circulated to all coordinators and schedule facilitators in advance of the APACA meeting. If there are more than three nominations, then a ballot will be held at APACA/5 in Toronto.</p>
